Come over submit limitations

In 2003 Turnitin force a creation of “student account” inside the class to be able to submit your paper.

One student can submit 3 times and then a 24 hours wait time applied “ **the similarity report will be generated after 24 hours**”.

To come over this limitation if needed:


You can create new student account and delete it after 3 submissions and create new student account for new 3 submission and continue deleting and creating the student accounts.

Or create new assignment and student can submit 3 times in this new assignment.

Come over submit limitations - 2

Use Quick Submit method

Quick Submit allow submitting papers without the need of creating student account and you can submit as many papers as you need and no wait intervals applied.




Quick Submit - Activating



Similarity Report : Reduce similarity

To avoid high similarity scores, reword ideas in your own words and list all sources used.

Use filters to refine the score of similarity

1- Exclude Quotes

- When the Exclude Quotes filter is active, the report will ignore any matches that use the following quotation marks (as well as quotations within a quotation):

2- Exclude Bibliography

- For submissions written in English, a machine-learning algorithm detects bibliographic reference materials when **Exclude Bibliography** filter is active. For submissions written in languages other than English, common beginning and terminating phrases are detected to exclude a section dedicated to references.

Similarity Report : Reduce similarity

It is better to add the word "References" at the beginning or in Arabic "المراجع"

See example how it is affect the report

With the word "المراجع" Turnitin ignores all text after that from similarity





Filters can reduce similarity, see three examples below





Similarity Report : Reduce similarity

Always use a clear style for your references. This means picking one way to list them and sticking to it throughout your work. Most academic papers use styles like APA, MLA, or Chicago.

Bibliography creators like Zotero and Mendeley simplify the process of constructing bibliographies, by organizing references in the correct manner, such that your reference list aligns with scholarly norms.


Feedback Studio

- Feedback studio allows you to **add comments** where needed at similarity report, to let student pay attention to some paragraphs that's either needs to be cited or paraphrased.
- You can add also **a voice message** to tell student your notes and directions for over all file.
- Student can't add notes only instructor.
- Click feedback studio icon 
- You can add voice or text message

- To add text comments, click feedback studio icon and type your text (2)





- Also, you can click start recording button (1) above, add your voice comment and click stop recording button and then click save button.

Feedback Studio - 3





- To add voice comment



- You need to save the recording before closing the report


Feedback Studio - 4

- You can add comments for paragraphs and also highlight and mark them for better visualizing, to do that:
- 1- Click the feedback studio icon 
- 2- Click any where in the report, you see these icons 
- Click “T” to add inline text like this: *inline text*
- Or click the chat icon in the middle to add comments with formatted text and also you can insert links in it, you can mark and highlight text like below.



Feedback Studio - 5

- When student can see your feedback on his report? Well it is depends on your assignment settings.
- In assignment settings below, the default feedback release date is the same as assignment due date, in this case student can see your notes or feedback but he can't re-submit since due date is reached and it may not allowed to submit after due date.



A.I Tool


Using A.I generated content and applying humanizing tools can result in low similarity but can show high A.I score.

Turnitin shows very good discovering A.I content from ChatGPT either when using some tools to humanize the text.


Magor Requirement for A.I tool to work (tell date of workshop)

1. File number of words must be from 300 to 30,000 words
2. File must be written in a supported language: English, Spanish

A.I Tool – indicators



Blue with a percentage of 0 or between 20 and 100: The submission has processed successfully. The displayed percentage indicates the amount of qualifying text within the submission that Turnitin's AI writing detection model determines was generated by AI.



Low percentage (*%): False positives (incorrectly flagging human-written text as AI-generated) are a possibility in AI models. To avoid potential incidence of false positives, no score or highlights are attributed for AI detection scores in the 1% to 19% range



Gray with no percentage displayed (- -): The AI writing detection indicator is unable to process this submission



Error (!): This error means that Turnitin has failed to process the submission. This state means that the AI writing report cannot be opened

A.I Tool – 3

- A.I generated text can be taken from ChatGBT or tools like it.
- To test chatgpt visit this link: <https://openai.com/index/chatgpt/>
- Text then can be humanized or paraphrased using many tools, for example
- **Scribber** (<https://www.scribbr.com/paraphrasing-tool/>)
- **Writehuman** (<https://writehuman.ai/>)
- These tools have different limitations regarding amount of text that can be processed.
- Turnitin A.I tool for detecting such generated text it self is like growing A.I learned algorithm that is evolving with time. So some times it can't detect such humanized text and some times it does not.
- Also in some cases A.I tool considered own writing text as A.I generated one. So you need to rephrase and change text.




